
#### MISSION STATEMENT

## FOLLOWING GUIDANCE



Centralia School District is following the guidance from local, state, and federal agencies in our reopening plans.

We are also taking into consideration the impact to families, instructional benefits, feasibility, as well as input from our stakeholders including our parents, Associations, staff, and administrators.

## HEALTH & SAFETY

The guidance in the areas of health and safety can be categorized into these five key components: Healthy Hygiene, Physical Distancing, Limiting gatherings and group sizes, Trainings, and Disinfecting.

Modified protocols will be based on the best available public health data and guidance at this time, international best practices currently employed, and the practical realities of managing school operations.

As new data and guidance emerge, the protocols will be updated.

## HEALTH AND SAFETY

### 1. Promote Healthy Hygiene Practices

- Healthy hygiene practices will be promoted. Handwashing/ sanitizing products will be provided to students and staff, however, they are welcome to bring their own hand sanitizer bottles. We will teach the use of cloth face coverings, masks, or face shields.

### 2. Physical Distancing

- Measures for social distancing will be implemented inside and outside the classroom.
- Nonessential visitors, volunteers and activities involving other groups will be limited at this time.

### 3. Limit Gatherings and Group Sizes

- We will be limiting large gatherings and group sizes. Large gatherings such as assemblies will not be held until further notice.


### 4. Train All Staff, Students, and Families

- Staff, students, and families will receive trainings and educational materials on following safety actions.

### 5. Cleaning, Disinfecting, and Sanitizing

- Our staff have begun preparing our schools for reopening in August. Our custodial and maintenance staff will be going through deep cleaning, sanitizing, and disinfecting of each school to ensure that our schools are ready for our students and staff to return.
- Upon reopening of schools, staff will clean and disinfect frequently-touched surfaces within the school, as practicable, frequently throughout the day.

# INSTRUCTIONAL OPTIONS



At this time, as California and Orange County are entering into Phase 3 of the state's reopening criteria, CESD is considering the following academic models to meet the needs of our students and families:

- **Full Distance Learning:** Child receives instruction via online Distance Learning/ Virtual Learning at home only.
- **Hybrid/Blended Model** if available: Combination of In-Person Learning at school AND Distance Learning at home. More information will be provided if the state provides the waiver to permit this model.
- **In-Person Learning:** Child receives instruction at school every day.
